A: That update is scheduled for release later this year

A: We do not sell a repeater to controller cable, a DB15 connector and cable will need to be obtained from a third party source

A: We expect to have an update for WIRES-X and DR-1X compatibility by the end of this year

A: System Fusion is not compatible with Moto Turbo

A: Hello AI, all software update are on our website. Please check the files tab under the DR-1X product page

Q: Can the FT1D radio decode any of the digital formats being used by the public safety police and fire who are using Motorola Mototrbo?

A: The FT1DR will only decode System Fusion C4FM, it will not decode P25 or Moto Turbo

Audience Question:

Q: FT2DR color screen?

A: Hello David, the screen is not color it is only monochrome.

Q: Can you guys Teamviewer into my fusion system?

Q: Will the DR-1X ever support a phone patch without having to use an external controller?

A: I am afraid not. special applications like that will require an external controller.

Audience Question:

Q: When I ground pin 1 on the 15 pin connector, I do not get any remote indication of the front panel. Is this normal operation? I do get the remote indication when selecting remote from the front panel.

A: Grounding pin 1 will put the repeater in BASE mode (repeater is disabled). The REMOTE setting in the SETUP menu enables pins 11 through 14 from input from an external controller.

Q: I was a little late coming in wondering if you could recap a little on wires-x.

Q: Any others having problems with the ftm-100dr changing through the memory banks. Say you're on one channel and look back then you're 4 or 5 channels away from where you were.

A: There is a software update available for download from our website that addresses that problem

Audience Question:

Q: Is there a way of getting data or pictures out of the radio so you can send it by other means without having to take out the sd cards. Or a way to send pictures from another source through the radio.

A: Hi David. The radio can only send pictures taken from the optional camera microphone. I have not been able to get externally created pictures to be sent by the radio. The radio creates a log to locate the images it has taken, but I have not figured out a way to recreate the log so the radio can find those picture. At this time, I would say only locally taken pictures can be sent.

Audience Question:

Q: Why doesn't the FT2 work "in band" memory mode on the b band? Works great on A but at all on B.

A: Hi Devon, the manual does not make a specific reference to only working on the A band. It will have to be something we will have to check in the office tomorrow. Can you call us tomorrow (714) 827-7600.

Audience Question:

Q: Is there a way to make the FT2DR show the memory name instead of the frequency, especially in dual receive mode?

A: From my own use I have only been able to use the name function in single band operation. I would have to continue to test it tomorrow to confirm. I believe you have found the same? I also didn't find reference I the manual in the name section until it refers to a single band mode.
